Sometimes police want to check your car for the right safety items, sometimes they want to see your passport, and other times they're looking for a "bad guy." But, we learned to trust God for the favor he's promised us, and to walk in it. Thanks to Him, we rarely get stopped anymore. He's so good!

Thanks for caring about the ministry God has given us here. It's a special one. We are grateful for the Mission Team that came from Greenwood Christian Academy last year, for the school God's given us in Costa Rica, and for what we've been able to give to our friend, Pastor Thomas in Nepal, Asia. (Please remember the horrible earthquake they suffered through this last year.)

Scott and I set aside some special time to pray and seek God recently, and we feel that this is a special year for our students and parents at Uvita Christian Academy (UCA). Their hearts are getting softer, and they're steps closer to knowing Jesus as Lord. We are also really excited to host another Mission Team in July 2016 - this year, not only are GCA students welcomed, but it's open to the general public. 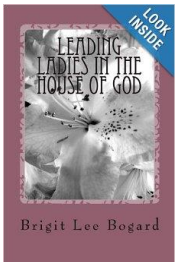
## Mission Trips Hosted

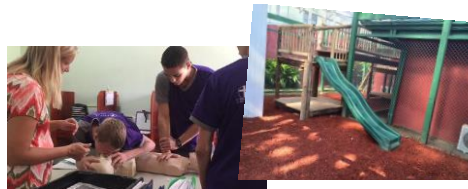
